

Field Maps updates

Occasionally you need to refresh your Field Maps app to ensure you have the most up to date features/functionality.



Your mobile device may automatically update the app (depending on your settings) or you may need to go to the app store and manually enable updates.


We also update the map from time to time. When we do, you need to remove and redownload any offline areas (if you use them). We will advise the project lead of these updates.

To (1) remove an old offline area and (2) download a new offline area

(1) Remove old offline area


Ensure you have synced any data from your device. Go to the “Maps” page in Field Maps (select the top left arrow to return to the list of maps areas available to you). Choose the thumbnail of the offline Map Area(s) you want to remove, select the three dots to the right...

...and then select ‘Remove area’



(2) Download new offline area

The offline map areas will be listed beneath the thumbnail for the Online map. Scroll to the map area you want to download and select the arrow over the horizontal line. This will begin the download to your device – a cross within a blue circle will appear while it downloads. It should take a few minutes at most and requires a good




internet connection. Once the circle is complete, your new offline area is on your device and ready to use.

Not sure if you have the online or offline map area?

If you zoom out and can see all of NZ you have the online map open.

If you zoom out and the map area only



shows the extent of your project area you are on the offline map.

You need to use the offline map if your project area does not have good reception.
